The <u>yearbooks</u> of Wake Forest School of Medicine (formerly Bowman Gray School of Medicine) and North Carolina Baptist Hospital School of Nursing are now available to the world thanks to the <u>North Carolina Digital Heritage Center</u>.

The Center's goal is to digitize "hidden" and statewide historical interest collections from institutions which do not have the staff or equipment to make them available on the Internet. The yearbook collection is one of several types of materials being digitized by staff and machines rented from the <u>Internet Archive</u>. The Center, funded by a grant, is housed in the <u>Louis R. Wilson Special Collections Library</u> at UNC Chapel Hill.
